

# Deer Creek Pool Rules

Summer means fun in the sun by the pool! The following pool rules are in place to make the community pool a fun and safe place for everyone to enjoy. Please review these rules and share them with your family and guests. Pool facilities are for the enjoyment of residents. Guest usage may be limited at the discretion of management.

- Pools have no lifeguards on duty. Anyone using the pools does so at his/her own risk.
- Children under the age of 16, must be accompanied by an adult.
- Showering is recommended prior to entering the pool or spa.
- No glass or animals in the fenced pool area.
- No food or beverages in the pool.
- Incontinent swimmers of all ages including toddlers, must wear approved swim diapers made for swimming. Defecating in the water will result in closing the pool for an appropriate period of time, for cleaning and sanitation.
- Any person having a skin disease, sores or inflamed eyes, nasal or ear infection or any communicable disease should refrain to use the pool facilities.
- Do not swallow the water, it is recirculated.
- Pools will be closed after adding heavy doses of chemicals to the water as eye/skin damage could result.
- Please help us maintain a clean environment in the pool and patio areas. Dispose of all litter and cans in trash containers.
- Management is not responsible for loss of personal property.
- Every precaution is taken to ensure your safety. If, for any reason, the pool and/or patio are deemed unsafe for use, the facility will be closed immediately and will remain closed until the city, state and/or management deem the area safe to use.
- Pool hours are dawn to dusk.
- No diving.
- No smoking in pool area.
- No running or rough playing in or around pools. Boisterous behavior and feats of daring exhibition that could jeopardize your personal safety and safety of other are prohibited.
- Noise such as audio equipment and/or voice levels, must be maintained at reasonable level.
- Pregnant woman, small children, people with health problems and people using alcohol, narcotics or other drugs that cause drowsiness should not use the pool/spa without first consulting a doctor.
- Owners are responsible for the actions of their guests/renters.
- All the above pool rules also apply to the spas.
- Maximum use for spa is 15 minutes.
- Management reserves the right to refuse entrance to any person(s), who in their judgement, is/are in violation of the rules and regulations. Management also has the authority to close for inclement weather.
